LAV-SAFE

Lav-Safe is a hard surface cleaner specifically formulated for use in restrooms and shower rooms on porcelain, vitreous enamel, showers, sinks, toilet bowls, urinals, metal fixtures, drinking fountains, glass, copper, brass, chrome, nickel, and stainless steel. It is convenient and safe-to-use, and comes as a ready-to-use liquid. Lav-Safe is acid-free, yet works as well as acid cleaners while having the added benefit of a pleasant residual odor.

Lav-Safe clings to vertical surfaces to get ultimate cleaning action. Like all acid-free tile and bowl cleaners, Lav-Safe will not harm porcelain or metal surfaces.

Used daily, Lav-Safe will keep restroom and shower room surfaces sparkling clean and fresh smelling. Lav-Safe is also useful as a deodorizer to eliminate noxious odors from urine, smoke and other organically caused odors.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

TOILET BOWLS & URINALS:

1. Apply LAV-SAFE to insides of bowl above water line.
2. Clean side and bottom with bowl brush or mop.
3. Flush until clean.

TILE WALLS:

1. Apply LAV-SAFE undiluted to tile surface.
2. Leave solution in place for 5 minutes.
3. Scour grout lines with nylon abradant pad.
4. Rinse with clean water.

GENERAL CLEANING:

1. Dilute 1 part LAV-SAFE with 2 parts cold water.
2. Apply to soiled surface with moistened mop, sponge, cloth or sprayer.
3. Scour with nylon abradant pad.
4. Rinse with clean water using sponge or hose.
