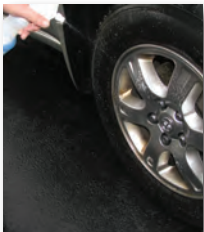

HAZARD STATEMENT

Flammable liquid and vapor. May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways. Causes skin irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Very toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking. Use explosion-proof electrical/ventilating/lighting equipment. Take precautionary measures against static discharge. Avoid breathing dust/fume/gas/mist/vapors/spray. Wash skin thoroughly after handling. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of workplace. Wear protective gloves/ protective clothing and eye safety protection. If swallowed, immediately call a poison center or doctor/physician. If on skin, immediately remove all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Do NOT induce vomiting. If skin irritation or rash occurs, get medical attention. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. In case of fire, use dry sand, dry chemical or alcohol-resistant foam for extinction. Collect spillage. Store in well-ventilated area. Keep cool. Store securely. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local, state, federal and international regulations. Offer surplus and non-recyclable solutions to a licensed disposal company.

FIRST AID

SWALLOWED: Harmful if swallowed. Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting. Call an emergency medical professional. **SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Rinse affected areas with plenty of soap and water/shower. If skin irritation occurs, get medical attention. **INHALED:** Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. **EYES:** Rinse carefully with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention.
