STETCO TILE & BOWL CLEANER

Stetco Tile and Bowl Cleaner is a highly effective mild acid cleaner formulated for use in restrooms and shower rooms. Safe for use on all bathroom fixtures except wood. Easily removes rust stains, heavy soap film, lime and algae deposits. Tile and Bowl leaves any surface clean and sparkling. Use on porcelain, vitreous enamel, shower room fixtures, wash basins, toilet bowls, urinals, metal fixtures, drinking fountains, glass, copper, brass, chrome, nickel and stainless steel. Tile and Bowl is a non-fuming, non-corrosive liquid cleaner and deodorizer that leaves a pleasant scent after use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

WARNING: Do not mix with bleach, ammonia or other cleaning products.

GENERAL CLEANING:

- 1. Apply undiluted to soiled surface with moistened mop, sponge, cloth or nozzle tip.
- 2. Scour with nylon abradant pad.
- 3. Rinse with clean water using sponge or hose.

TILE WALLS:

- 1. Apply undiluted to tile surface.
- 2. Leave solution in place for 1 5 minutes.
- 3. Scour grout lines with nylon abrasive pad.
- 4. Rinse with clean water.

TOILET BOWLS & URINALS:

- Apply undiluted to inside of bowl above water line.
- 2. Clean side and bottom with bowl brush or mop.
- 3. Flush until clean.
